CENTRAL NORTH ISLAND

The Cathedral Cove Classic Kayak Tour \$145.00

Hahei Explorer Cathedral Cove Boat Tour \$95.00

WELLINGTON

Wellington Te Papa Museum \$35

Open 10am-6pm. Te Papa is New Zealand's national museum, renowned for being bicultural, scholarly, innovative, and fun. Collections span five areas: Art, History, Pacific, Māori, and Natural Environment.

Botanical Gardens Free

Open 10am - 3pm. Visit Wellington Botanic Garden and enjoy its 25ha of unique landscape, protected native forest, conifers, specialised plant collections, colourful floral displays, and views over Wellington city. To get there take the Cable Car (\$4 one way)- from Cable Car Lane, off Lambton Quay. Leaves every 10 minutes to the top of the Botanic Garden. You can then take the downhill walk back to the city.

Tekapo Hot Pools \$37.00

Dark Sky Experience \$50.00

Embark on a journey 13.8 billion years in the making with this multimedia indoor astronomy experience (please note this does not include any stargazing through telescopes) that combines science and tātai aroraki (Māori astronomy). Duration: 45 minutes.

Crater Experience \$129.00

Discover the depths of the world renowned Aoraki Mackenzie International Dark Sky Reserve from our purpose-built stargazing observation craters, sheltered from the cold wind and light pollution. Explore the endless Southern skies, observe planets, galaxies, and the depths of the Milky Way. Every night sky beholds something different, and our expert astronomy guides use handheld lasers to showcase the best of the evolving night sky. The Crater Experience runs for 1 hour 15 minutes and includes: transport to and from Cowan's Private Observatory, guided naked eye discovery of the Southern skies and viewing through our telescopes. If weather conditions do prevent us from taking you on the Crater Experience, you'll still experience the wonder of our Southern Skies with our guides from the comfort of our indoor Virtual Stargazing Experience and receive a partial refund.

Oamaru Blue Penguin Colony \$58.00

QUEENSTOWN

Skyline Gondola (return trip) \$64.00

Before or after lunch you'll be treated to an entertaining farm show including working sheep dogs and sheep shearing with the rural demonstrator giving you an insight into life in the New Zealand high country.

Shotover Jet \$169.00

1.5hrs (25 minutes on the water). Speed along the famous Shotover River and deep into the spectacular Shotover River Canyons.

Kawarau Jet to Raft \$299.00

40min jet boat ride + 2hr rafting. Combine two of Queenstown's most iconic experiences as you discover the Kawarau River by jetboat and raft. Paddle and swim your way through grade 2-3 whitewater rapids (perfect if this is your first time whitewater rafting) with a cliff jumping section for the adventure junkies!
